

## Top Tips for College Math or Stats Course Success

1. **Go to class.** You will learn more when you see, hear, and do than you will just from reading a book or doing assigned homework.
2. **Read the book.** It is helpful to read the book before and after class to get an idea of what will be covered and then to solidify the information.
3. **Ask questions.** Clarify confusion sooner rather than later. If you have a question, odds are at least one other person in the room has the same or a similar question.
4. **Participate in class.** The more you participate, the better you will understand and the easier it will be to answer questions on the homework and exams.
5. **Do ALL homework.** Even if it is not collected, complete all homework. Practice makes perfect and also makes the exams much easier.
6. **Get help.** At BGSU, you have your instructor and the Math & Stats Tutoring Center available at no extra cost to help you be successful. Use the services to your benefit.
7. **Prepare for exams.** The earlier you start studying, the more you will remember. Study at least one hour per day for up to a week before the exam. Cramming will not help in a math or stats course where material builds on itself.
